Only 20% of Jewish children experience the life-changing magic of Jewish camp. We will bring more Jewish camp to more people. We will:

- 1. Orient all aspects of the organization to active outreach and promotion of Jewish camp, especially to the 80% of families not currently choosing Jewish camp.
- 2. Evaluate the costs and benefits of providing mission-based Herzl experiences for a broad spectrum of age groups throughout the year. Determine Herzl's path.
- 3. Expand and enhance young alumni engagement opportunities.

Maximize Camp's Impact

Recognizing that Herzl serves as a main portal to positive Jewish life for campers and staff, we will maximize the impact of the camp program. We will:

- 1. Focus and deepen intentional integration of meaningful Jewish experiences and Israel into the camp program.
- 2. Strive for programmatic excellence in key investment areas, engaging camper/parent interests and integrating into Herzl's long-standing tradition of making mensches.
- 3. Establish objective measures and methods to evaluate camp's impact.

Advance Camp's Mission

To maximize opportunities to advance Herzl's mission, we will ensure that governance structures are effective and aligned with camp's strategic goals. We will:

- 1. Align lay leader structures to fully support camp and camp's community including committees, boards, and legacy leader roles.
